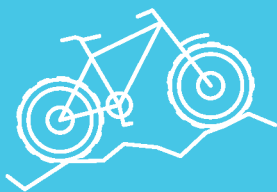
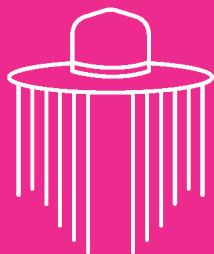
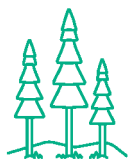

## ✦ Amealco de Bonfil

### Lele Doll Museum:

Enclosure dedicated to woven dolls in the communities of San Ildefonso Tultepec and Santiago Mexquititlán, as well as cultural expressions by artists from this city.

### Capital Flow

The fun never ends for cyclists. This bike park in Amealco has a camping area next to the wide variety of tracks to explore to the maximum.

### Traditional Food:

Mole de Guajolote and pulque are staple delicacies in Amealco. A heritage dish of colonial recipes that survive to this day; another, pre-Hispanic drink par excellence.

### Cerro de la Cruz

The indigenous people of Chupícuaro inhabited it before the arrival of the Spaniards, now it is a natural space, ideal for hiking or mountain biking.

## ✦ Huimilpan

### Cheese Factories:

Pradales and Rancho San Josemaría are 2 cheese factories with truly experiences who make you feel the farmer life. Taste the unique flavors of all these kind of Cheese.

### Gastronomy

Huimilpan is a such famous place in Queretaro for the food. The Confited Pork (Carnitas) Fried Pork Skin (Chicarron), Barbacoa and "sangrita de borrego", the roads and the main plaza are a truly gastronomic atmosphere.

## ✦ Pedro Escobedo

### Art in Quarry

In this municipality of great industrial development, it still preserves traditions as old as the Spanish conquest itself. Limestone abounds in its territory, which is why artisans have made the quarry the material for their artistic expressions.

### Haciendas

This municipality in the south of the state of Querétaro houses among its extensive valleys impressive haciendas that were an important part of the wealth generated and distributed by the Camino Real de Tierra Adentro.

### More Touristic Places

In the squares and markets of Pedro Escobedo you can buy a wide variety of ornamental pieces, quarry work, and other creations made with great skill.

## ✦ San Juan del Río

### Tithe Portal

Emblematic building on San Juan del Río, located on Camino Real de Tierra Adentro, in this place tithe taxes were collected by the Spanish Crown. At the moment is important cultural center of San Juan del Río, you can find the best artistic and cultural offer on a regular basis.

### Museum of Death

Housed in the facilities of the old and beautiful Santa Vera Cruz Cemetery, which dates back to the 18th century, its purpose is to present the funerary rites of our societies through time: pre-Hispanic burials, altars and traditional offerings.

### Hill and Neighborhood of the Santa Cruz

In this ceremonial center in pre-Hispanic times, and later a place of Catholic worship and popular festivals, you can see a hermitage built in 1679 to venerate the Santa Cruz.

### History Bridge

It was built to facilitate the crossing of the San Juan River during the flood season. Standing since 1710, it is one of the most important symbols of San Juan del Río. Prepare a picnic to spend a day outdoors with your family or simply enjoy the nature that this place offers you.



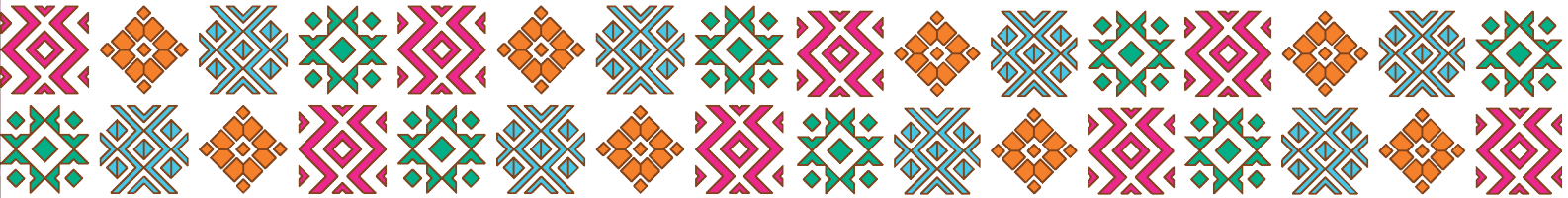
